



A new larva of the genus Ceraclea Stephens, 1829?

What is it? I think it is a species of *Ceraclea*. I found this larva in Pasłękka River in Poland. Head and submentum golden yellow, pronotum pale straw with yellow band. No sclerotization of meso- and metadorsal tergites. Ninth abdominal tergite without sclerotization.

Figs.: A, B: larval head, C: pronotum, D: mandible, E: case.


