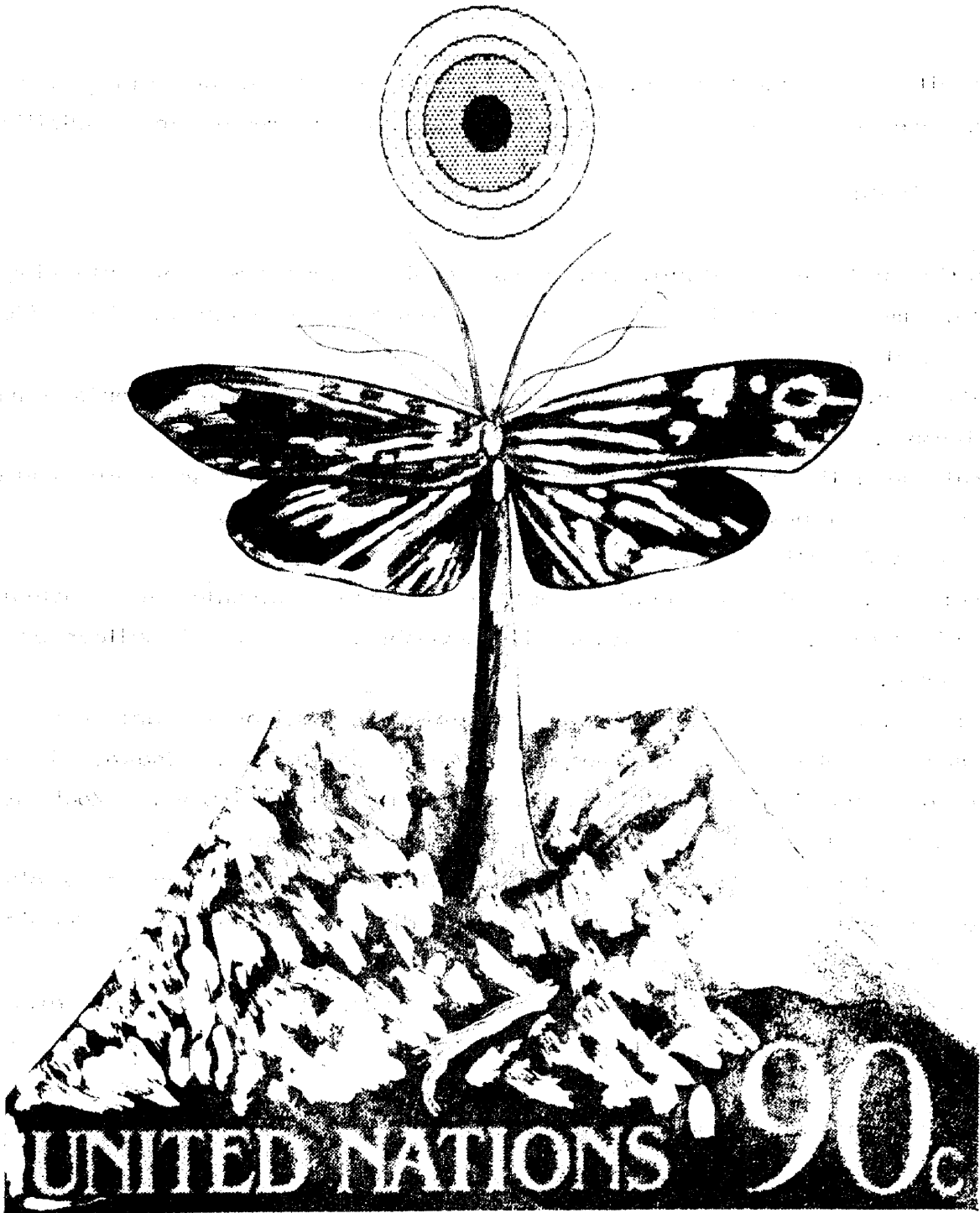
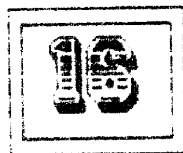

SOME INFORMATION ON A LARVA OF TRIAENODES

Occasionally in stagnant water I have caught unusual larvae of the genus Triaenodes. These larvae resemble larvae of Triaenodes bicolor in the legs and case, but the submentum is triangular (Fig.c), like that of Athripsodes. I could not find information in the literature to solve this problem. I looked for differences between T.bicolor and this species in their habitats but without success. I am breeding these larvae. There are chances that they are younger instars of T.bicolor (?).
