

Competition for the Co-Investigator Position

The University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn will employ, on the basis of a civil law contract, a Co-Investigator-type grant contractor entitled: "Interdisciplinary Forum of Scientific Excellence. Competitiveness-Measurability-Innovation. Internationalisation of the heritage of Polish criminological thought and increasing the recognition of its achievements" adopted for funding by way of a competition announced on 24 January 2019 by the Minister of Science and Higher Education as part of the programme called "DIALOG" established by the Communication of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of 23 January 2019 on the establishment of the programme called "Dialogue", in order to perform, in particular, the following tasks:

1. Query in the Ukrainian library and archive collections.
2. Digitisation and copying of data.
3. Completion, structuring, selection and archiving of research material.

Requirements for the candidate:

1. Master's degree (preferably in the humanities or social sciences).
2. Availability and readiness to work in an irregular time frame (during fieldwork).
3. Academic achievements in humanities or social sciences.
4. Additionally confirmed experience in the implementation of grants will be scored.
5. Additionally the knowledge of German, Lithuanian, Ukrainian and Russian language will be scored.

Documents required from the candidate:

1. Description of the candidate's scientific achievements to date.
2. List of the candidate's scientific publications.
3. Confirmation of research work, including grants received, implemented and completed.
4. Optional recommendation letter.
5. Document confirming the knowledge of a foreign language.



The employer offers an opportunity to:

1. Participate in the research activities of a group of highly motivated scientists.
2. Enrichment of research experience and scientific achievements.
3. Work in the inspiring scientific atmosphere of the new research team.

The competition is open. The competition procedure will be conducted by a five-person committee appointed by the grant manager, consisting of the grant manager as the chairman, three members of the research team with appropriate scientific or professional qualifications and a representative of the Dean. The committee will examine the proposals in an evaluation:

1. Compliance with formal requirements (completeness and fulfillment of the conditions set out in the competition notice).
2. The candidates' competence to carry out the specific tasks in the grant.
3. The candidates' academic achievements.
4. The candidate's awards and distinctions resulting from the research.

The decision of the committee may be appealed against to the Deputy Rector for Science.

Deadline for submitting applications: 20 November 2020, date as per postmark.
