Substantive content

CLASSES: Practicing the practical application of information on the pronunciation and grammatical structure of English, which students will be introduced to during lectures.

LECTURES: English vowels, differences between Polish and English vowels, vowel reduction; diphthongs; consonants, differences between Polish and English consonants; accent and intonation; weak and strong forms; assimilation; elision; definite and indefinite article; nouns - singular and plural, gender, Saxon genitive; adjectives - creation, gradation; personal, relative, possessive, indefinite and interrogative pronouns; main and ordinal numbers, adverbs - creation and gradation; prepositions; auxiliary and imperfective verbs; basic grammar times; passive voice; conditional modes.

Learning purpose: To acquaint students with the basic principles of English pronunciation and the basic structures of English grammar.

On completion of the study programme the graduate will gain:

Knowledge: Students know the basic principles of English pronunciation and basic structures of English grammar.

Skills: Students are able to acquire knowledge in the field of the subject Phonetics and practical grammar of English.
