CLASSES: none

LECTURES: The detailed scope of the lecture: The legal system in Poland. Outline of the history of law. The influence of Roman law on current legal norms. The concept, features and functions of law. Limits of the law. Basic legal concepts. Sources of law, construction of legal text. Creating the law and applying the law. Basics of legislative technique. Elements of administrative law - legal bases, state and local government bodies, competences, operating principles. Basics of property law. Land and mortgage register as the basis for disclosing legal information about real estate and the Land and Building Register as the basis for disclosing technical information about real estate - introduction.

Learning purpose: The student learns the basic legal concepts and the legal system in Poland.

On completion of the study programme the graduate will gain:

Knowledge: The student has basic knowledge about various types of structures and social institutions, in particular their legal elements.

Skills: The student can - when formulating and solving engineering tasks - perceive their legal aspects.
