Substantive content

CLASSES: Odontogenic inflammations – their medical significance. Basics of surgical suturing – Z, Y, W, cosmetic dentistry. The examination of a craniofacial diseases patient. First aid of craniofacial traumas. Craniofacial inflammations – diagnosis, differentiation, treatment.

LECTURES: Learning purpose: To acquire knowledge of a structure of an osseous tissue of a facial part of a skull and an influence of diverse factors on its development. To gain information about craniofacial inflammations, oral and maxillofacial traumas and oncology of the area. To study examination and treatment methods with an imperative on surgical activities. To use the knowledge during pre-, peri- and intraoperative medical care.
