Substantive content

CLASSES 1. Communication in an interdisciplinary team. The role of a leader and team members. Communication for patient safety. 2. Intercultural communication. Language barrier. Differences in cultural customs and habits and medical practice. Showing respect. Active listening. Recognition of cultural differences. Concentration on solving the problem. 3. The patient's family. Rules of communication. The role of the family and surroundings in the therapeutic process. 4. Social determinants of health and communication.
