Substantive content

CLASSES: Polish alphabet. Pronunciation of Polish speech sounds. Numbers 1-1000. Basic vocabulary: food, places in town, family, house etc. Basic adjectives and adverbs. Participating in a conversation at the A1 level. Greetings. Speaking about present activities. Shopping. Asking for directions. Making appointments. Basic questions and talk about place and time. Determining the gender of a noun. Recognizing and creating the forms of nominative, accusative, instrumental, in chosen nouns and adjectives. Nominative, instrumental and accusative forms of personal pronouns. Possesives and demonstratives in nominative. Basic prepositions (accusative, instrumental, genitive). Conjugating basic verbs in the right conjugation in present tense.

LECTURES: - (only classes)

Learning purpose: Command of Polish language in everyday situations at the A1 level. Preparation to talk with patients. Knowledge of Polish grammar and vocabulary at the beginner's level.

Knowledge: The student knows the basics of Polish grammar and basic Polish vocabulary (A1)

Skills: The student communicates at the very basic level of Polish (A1).

Social Competencies: The student works regularly on the improvement of his command of Polish language.
