#### Substantive content

**CLASSES:** Classes are devoted to important concepts and constructions of civil law; they are designed to familiarize students with the theoretical achievements and scientific work in the field of civil law. They take into account the historical and comparative perspective, focus on the achievements of doctrine and science of civil law. During the course the following issues will be discussed: a person - a subject of civil law, prenatal damages, personal rights, a declaration of intent in the digital world, contracts with the participation of consumers, marriage versus partnership, property versus intellectual property.
