CLASSES: Definition, concept and aim of inheritance law. Statutory succession in chosen European Union countries. Testate capacity and its relation to legal capacity and capacity to undertake legal actions. Testate succession (forms of testaments, dispositions, cases). Inheritance rights in Africa. Copyright inheritance. Contracts of donation and annuity - regulations and connections with inheritance law. Tax regulations. The need for the harmonization of inheritance law.
