Substantive content:

CLASSES: none

LECTURES: The composition and contents of the Old and New Testament; their understanding and place in Judaism and Christianity; ancient and modern principles of interpretation. Main idea of the Bible: the relation between God and humans (covenant and revelation). Main doctrines concerning God, Jesus Christ, world, humanity and ethics (monotheism, salvation through Christ, creation, human nature, commandments). The most famous biblical books (Genesis, Gospels, Revelation) and selected important and interesting fragments.

Learning purpose: Preparing for the lecture of the Bible with sufficient understanding.

On completion of the study programme the graduate will gain:

Knowledge: Basic knowledge of the ideas of the Bible as foundation of Christian faith and European culture.

Skills: Preparation for future use of popular and scholarly literature concerning Bible and Christianity.

Social Competencies: Being able to interact with Christians making appeal to the Bible.

Basic literature: New Dictionary of Biblical Theology

Supplementary literature: Hayes, Holladay, Biblical Exegesis; Stanton, Gospels and Jesus; HarperCollins Bible Dictionary.
