<b>Description***</b>	<p>Studies in the field of economics, on the specialty European economic development, allow obtaining a comprehensive knowledge of economic theory and of the essence, conditions and principles of management process. Student learns the principles of human and financial resources management, gains the knowledge and skills necessary to conduct economic analyzes, to formulate opinions on economic issues at micro and macro level and to make rational economic decisions. Training also includes knowledge, skills and competences in the field of, among others, microeconomic competitiveness, international financial markets, euromarketing, European economic integration and European labour market. Student learns about economic policies applied in the European Union, mechanism of euro zone functioning and financial strategies of multinational companies. Furthermore one can develop competencies in the field of international business, international logistics and investment management. Student in cooperation with the supervisor conducts research and write a master degree thesis.</p> <p>Graduates are able to analyze problems and process of an international nature, understand the basic concepts, tools and the importance of economic policies under different economic determinants. They also understand the essence of economic mechanisms operating in the field of international cooperation. Graduates have the foundations to work in multinational companies, financial institutions and government entities responsible for the implementation of various policies of the European Union.</p>

<b>Institution***</b>	The Faculty of Economics
<b>Education requirements***</b>	Completed bachelor degree course in field of economics or related. An original diploma of first-degree studies completed in Poland or a legalized diploma of higher education institution issued abroad, entitling to undertake second-degree studies in the country where it was issued, recognized under the regulations, as equivalent to the Polish diploma of first-degree studies. Additionally, a certificate should be attached issued by the higher education institution, providing the final results of first-degree studies (without rounding up or down to the full grade, expressed to two decimal places).
<b>Additional requirements</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. An application addressed to the Pro-Rector for Student Affairs</li> <li>2. An application form and a CV (available on the Web site)</li> <li>3. An original general certificate of secondary education or other document (with a clause proving the right to apply for admission to higher education institution in the country where the certificate was issued) recognized as equivalent to the Polish general certificate of secondary education. This does not apply to certificates recognized under international agreements.</li> <li>4. An English Language Certificate</li> <li>5. A medical certificate allowing the bearer to undertake studies at the selected programme, according to current legal regulations.</li> <li>6. Three photographs 37 x 52 mm, taken without headgear, against a light background with CD attached.</li> <li>7. A photocopy of a passport (the page with a photo).</li> <li>8. A receipt proving the payment of the enrolment fee.</li> <li>9. A certificate of Polish origin (applies only to persons of Polish origin).</li> <li>10. A photocopy of Polish Charter (applies only to its holders).</li> <li>11. Proof of health insurance valid in Poland (European Union citizens- EHIC card) - after admission.</li> <li>12.
